1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the adjustment of the average daily attendance of a
 1-22 school district on the basis of a calamity.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 48.005(d), Education Code, is amended to
 1-25 read as follows:

1-26 (d) The commissioner may adjust the average daily
 1-27 attendance of a school district in which a disaster, flood, extreme
 1-28 weather condition, fuel curtailment, or other calamity has a
 1-29 significant effect on the district's attendance. In addition to
 1-30 providing the adjustment for the amount of instructional days
 1-31 during the semester in which the calamity first occurred, an
 1-32 adjustment under this section may only be provided based on a
 1-33 particular calamity for an additional amount of instructional days
 1-34 equivalent to one school year. The commissioner may divide the
 1-35 adjustment between two consecutive school years.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
