1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the dissolution of the Angelina County Water Control
 1-20 and Improvement District No. 4.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. (a) The directors of the Angelina County Water
 1-23 Control and Improvement District No. 4 shall wind up the affairs of
 1-24 the district.

1-25 (b) On the 60th day after the effective date of this Act:

1-26 (1) the Angelina County Water Control and Improvement
 1-27 District No. 4 is dissolved;

1-28 (2) the terms of the directors of the district expire;

1-29 (3) any remaining assets and liabilities of the
 1-30 district are transferred to the City of Diboll; and

1-31 (4) the territory of the district is added to the City
 1-32 of Diboll Sewer CCN No. 20150.

1-33 SECTION 2. Effective on the 61st day after the effective
 1-34 date of this Act, Chapter 1329, Acts of the 77th Legislature,
 1-35 Regular Session, 2001, is repealed.

1-36 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
 1-37 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
 1-38 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
 1-39 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
 1-40 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
 1-41 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
 1-42 Government Code.

1-43 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
 1-44 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
 1-45 Environmental Quality.

1-46 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
 1-47 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
 1-48 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
 1-49 representatives within the required time.

1-50 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
 1-51 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
 1-52 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
 1-53 and accomplished.

1-54 SECTION 4. Except as provided by Section 2 of this Act, this
 1-55 Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of
 1-56 all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39,
 1-57 Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the
 1-58 vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect
 1-59 September 1, 2021.
