1-24 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-25 AN ACT

1-26 relating to certain equipment provided for use by the officers of  
 1-27 the Texas Highway Patrol.

1-28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-29 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 411, Government Code, is  
 1-30 amended by adding Section 411.033 to read as follows:

1-31 Sec. 411.033. CERTAIN EQUIPMENT FOR VEHICLES. The  
 1-32 department shall equip all motor vehicles used by officers of the  
 1-33 Texas Highway Patrol in discharging the officers' official duties  
 1-34 with bullet-resistant windshields.

1-35 SECTION 2. The Department of Public Safety is required to  
 1-36 implement a provision of this Act only if the legislature  
 1-37 appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If the  
 1-38 legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that  
 1-39 purpose, the Department of Public Safety may, but is not required  
 1-40 to, implement a provision of this Act using other appropriations  
 1-41 available for that purpose.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-43 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-44 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
