2 WHEREAS, The family and friends of Everette Wayne McBride of
3 Mount Pleasant suffered an immeasurable loss with his death on
4 February 8, 2019, at the age of 73; and

5 WHEREAS, Born on October 25, 1945, in Dallas, "Skip" McBride
6 was the son of Wayne McBride and the former Mae Deen Harris, and he
7 grew up with the companionship of two siblings, Judith and Mike; he
8 married Louise McBride, with whom he shared a rewarding union, and
9 he took great pride in his children, Cynthia and Dennis, his
10 stepchildren, Candace, Toy, Amanda, and Chelsea, and his
11 grandchildren, Lauren, Dillon, Hayden, Brianna, Sofia, Paige, Mya,
12 and Major; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. McBride graduated from Woodrow Wilson High
14 School in Dallas, and in 1973, he attended the 30th Texas Game
15 Warden Training Academy at Texas A&M University; he spent 35 years
16 as a game warden captain in Northeast Texas, and he worked as a
17 Realtor with Century 21 Landmark Associates beginning in 2005; in
18 addition, he was a member of the Temple Masonic Lodge No. 70 in
19 Mount Pleasant; and

20 WHEREAS, Although Skip McBride is deeply missed, he has left
21 his family and friends with a wealth of memories that they will
22 forever treasure; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the 87th Legislature of the State of Texas
24 hereby pay tribute to the life of Everette Wayne McBride and extend

1 sincere sympathy to the members of his family and to his friends;
