1-15 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-16 WHEREAS, The original 1847 Colt Walker pistol was
 1-17 historically crucial to the early survival of the great State of
 1-18 Texas; and
 1-19 WHEREAS, The original 1847 Colt Walker pistol was an
 1-20 essential tool in the defeat of the Mexican army during the
 1-21 Mexican-American War to reclaim Texas, the 28th state of the Union;
 1-22 and
 1-23 WHEREAS, The co-inventor of the original 1847 Colt Walker
 1-24 pistol, Samuel Walker, was a captain in the Texas Rangers, the first
 1-25 state police agency in the country; and
 1-26 WHEREAS, The original 1847 Colt Walker pistol was America's
 1-27 first pistol to hold six rounds, otherwise known as a
 1-28 "six-shooter"; and
 1-29 WHEREAS, The original 1847 Colt Walker pistol is still the
 1-30 most powerful black powder pistol in existence; now, therefore, be
 1-31 it
 1-32 RESOLVED, That the 87th Legislature of the State of Texas
 1-33 hereby recognize the original 1847 Colt Walker pistol as the
 1-34 official handgun of the State of Texas.
