WHEREAS, Born on September 19, 1938, Bill Hedges grew up in Little Rock, Arkansas, with two siblings, Jerry Lee and Harold; he attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and he was a member of the Class of 1956 at Little Rock Central High School; after attending Hendrix College, he earned a history degree from Southern Methodist University and went on to graduate from the SMU Perkins School of Theology; and
