passing of Peter R. Rose of Austin on December 19, 2022, at the age

WHEREAS, A fifth-generation Texan, Pete Rose was born to Mary

5 Paterson and Llewellyn Rose on July 3, 1935, in Austin, and he grew

6 up with a brother, Pat, and a sister, Sally; he graduated from

7 Austin High School with the Class of 1953 and continued his

8 education at The University of Texas at Austin, where he earned

9 bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees in geology; and

10 WHEREAS, Over the course of his career as a geologist,

11 Mr. Rose worked for Shell, Stony Brook University, the

12 U.S. Geological Survey, and Energy Reserves Group, Inc.; in 1980,

13 he became an independent consulting geologist, and he spent a

14 number of years providing corporate training in petroleum

15 exploration risk analysis before founding Rose & Associates in

16 1999; over the years, he published more than 80 papers on a variety

17 of geotechnical topics as well as a definitive book on petroleum

18 exploration; he also gained a reputation as a leading authority on

19 the geology and history of the Edwards Plateau; and

20 WHEREAS, Active in his professional community, Mr. Rose

21 served as president of the American Association of Petroleum

22 Geologists and the Austin Geological Society, and he was a fellow of

23 a number of geological organizations; in recognition of his

24 accomplishments, he received the Silver Medal from the Geological

- 2 Leadership Award from AAPG; a man of faith, he was a valued
- 3 congregant of Westlake Hills Presbyterian Church; and
- WHEREAS, In 1956, Mr. Rose wed Judith Sue Drummond, and
- 5 though their marriage eventually ended, it brought into Mr. Rose's
- 6 life three beloved daughters, Virginia, Cathy, and Peggy; he later
- 7 married Karen Watkins, and they divorced in 1987; for 34 years, he
- 8 shared his life with Alice Haldeman Reid, whom he married in 1989,
- 9 and together they created a blended family that included his
- 10 stepchildren, Wally and Jennifer; with the passing years, he was
- 11 further blessed with eight grandchildren, Jack, Ben, Beau, Maya,
- 12 McKenna, McKittrick, Cade, and Edie; and
- WHEREAS, Although Pete Rose will be deeply missed, he has
- 14 left his family and friends with a wealth of memories that they will
