WHEREAS, In 1961, Mr. Harris married Claire Roberts, and they were blessed with three children, Miriam, Melissa, and Houston; after that marriage ended, he was fortunate enough to find love again with Risa Horner Harris, with whom he shared the last four decades of his life; in his leisure time, he enjoyed outdoor activities like fishing, golfing, hunting, and skiing, and he had
