## RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Ehlers-Danlos Syndromes and Hypermobility Spectrum
- 2 Disorders Awareness Month took place in May 2023; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Ehlers-Danlos syndromes (EDS) include 13 heritable
- 4 connective tissue disorders that together affect an estimated 1 in
- 5 5,000 people; each disorder has its own set of symptoms, but all
- 6 types of EDS are characterized by joint hypermobility, skin
- 7 hyperextensibility, and tissue fragility; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Hypermobility spectrum disorders (HSD) are
- 9 connective tissue disorders that cause joint hypermobility,
- 10 instability, injury, and pain; in addition, other symptoms such as
- 11 fatigue, headaches, gastrointestinal problems, and autonomic
- 12 dysfunction are often a result of HSD; and
- WHEREAS, There is currently no available cure for any type of
- 14 EDS or HSD, and treatments typically focus on addressing symptoms;
- 15 because the conditions can affect many different areas of the body,
- 16 patients often require multiple providers in different specialties
- 17 to manage their care; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Numerous patients impacted by EDS and HSD have
- 19 limited access to professionals who are knowledgeable about these
- 20 health issues; increased awareness about each condition is
- 21 necessary to help diagnose patients, improve symptom management,
- 22 and promote research initiatives; and
- WHEREAS, More work remains to be done to ensure that all EDS
- 24 and HSD patients have access to quality health care, and the
