**WHEREAS**, An esteemed educator and administrator, Dr. Paige served as the United States Secretary of Education from 2001 to 2005 under President George W. Bush; he championed the No Child Left Behind Act and helped raise national standards of excellence in public education; after his service as secretary of education, he held a position as a public policy fellow at the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Paige served as dean of the Texas Southern University College of Education and as the superintendent of the Houston Independent School District; he was the first African American to serve in that position, and in 2001, the American Association of School Administrators named him as National Superintendent of the Year; his unique style of leadership and his innovative approach to education established him as a revered figure in educational administration, and he has received many awards and accolades for his professional accomplishments; and

**WHEREAS**, A resident of Houston, Rod is a loving husband to his wife, Stephanie Nellons-Paige, and a proud father of his two children; his wisdom, his generous spirit, and the enthusiasm with which he approaches life are a source of inspiration to those around him, and his 90th birthday is indeed a fitting occasion for his loved ones to express their admiration and affection; now, therefore, be it
