(a) This 8 9 subsection applies only to a school district that has a wealth per student that exceeds the amount specified by Section 41.002(a)(1) 10 and that, for the school year beginning in the current tax year, has 11 entered into an agreement with the commissioner to purchase average 12 daily attendance credits as provided by Subchapter D, Chapter 41, 13 14 in an amount sufficient, in combination with any other actions taken under that chapter, to reduce the school district's wealth 15 16 per student to a level that is equal to or less than the equalized wealth level as determined by the commissioner under that chapter. 17 If the school district maintains a generally accessible Internet 18 19 website, the school district shall post on the website: (1) the percentage of the taxes for maintenance and 20 operations imposed by the school district for the current tax year 21

22 that the school district is required to pay under the agreement for 23 the school year beginning in the current tax year to purchase 24 average daily attendance credits; and

No. 105 1 (2) the percentage of the taxes for maintenance and operations imposed by the school district for the current tax year 2 that the school district is not required to pay under the agreement 3 for the school year beginning in the current tax year to purchase 4 5 average daily attendance credits. 6 (b) This subsection applies only to a school district to 7 which Subsection (a) does not apply. If the school district maintains a generally accessible Internet website, the school 8 district shall post on the website: 9 (1) the percentage of the maintenance and operations 10 revenue of the school district for the school year beginning in the 11 12 current tax year that is derived from taxes for maintenance and operations imposed by the school district for the current tax year; 13 14 (2) the percentage of the maintenance and operations 15 revenue of the school district for the school year beginning in the preceding tax year that was derived from taxes for maintenance and 16 17 operations imposed by the school district for the preceding tax year; 18 19 (3) the percentage of the maintenance and operations revenue of the school district for the school year beginning in the 20 current tax year that is derived from state funds distributed to the 21 22 school district; and (4) the percentage of the maintenance and operations 23 24 revenue of the school district for the school year beginning in the preceding tax year that was derived from state funds distributed to 25 26 the school district. 27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2024.
