10	the basic allotment under Section 48.051 and the dollar amount
11	guaranteed level of state and local funds per weighted student per
12	cent of tax effort ("GL") under Section 48.202 for each state fiscal
13	<pre>year at:</pre>
14	(1) the amounts necessary for the amount of state
15	funds to which all school districts are jointly entitled under this
16	chapter, together with state funds to which all school districts
17	are jointly entitled for that state fiscal year under any other law
18	that provides funding for the general maintenance and operation of
19	the system of public free schools, to constitute, as determined by
20	the legislature, at least 55 percent of the cost of maintaining and
21	operating that system; or
22	(2) amounts greater than the amounts specified by
23	Subdivision (1).

- 1 required under Subsection (a), the legislature may not consider
- 2 money that is attributable to an ad valorem tax imposed by a school
- 3 district on property located in the school district, including any
- 4 revenue the school district is required to transfer to the state to
- 5 reduce the school district's local revenue level in accordance with
- 6 Chapter 49.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
