13 WHEREAS, A lifelong activist, Dr. Pérez joined the American 14 GI Forum as a student and went on to become an active member of LULAC; she taught naturalization and English classes to many in her 15 16 community, and she encouraged Mexican Americans to participate in civic life and to exercise their right to vote; in addition, she 17 served as the director for the religious education program at 18 St. Joseph Catholic Church and volunteered her time on several 19 20 civic advisory boards in the San Angelo community; she and her 21 husband also had the distinction of being among the founding owners of La Unica Broadcasting, which was established in 1985; and 22

23 WHEREAS, Dr. Pérez was a firm believer in education, which 24 led her to pursue and complete a Ph.D. at The University of Texas at
