1 WHEREAS, Memories of joyful times and meaningful 2 accomplishments remain to comfort the family and friends of Harlon Brooks of Nacogdoches, who passed away on August 20, 2023, at the 3 age of 79; and 4 5 WHEREAS, The son of Gaylon and Topsie Brooks, Harlon Brooks was born in Nacogdoches on December 19, 1943, and he grew up with 6 the companionship of four sisters, Rose, Ella, Anita, and Mary; he 7 graduated from E. J. Campbell High School in 1961; and 8

WHEREAS, Mr. Brooks married his high school sweetheart, 9 Alfreddie, and the couple shared many happy years together until 10 11 his passing; they were blessed with two children, Candace and 12 Marlon, and their treasured family eventually grew to include five grandchildren, Gabriel, Jordan, Michael, Isaac, and Jacob; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Together with his wife and two of his friends, Mr. Brooks founded Harlon's BBQ in Houston in 1977; the restaurant 15 originally operated out of a former gas station in the South Park 16 neighborhood, and it later became one of the first Black-owned 17 18 businesses to establish sites at major airports and to serve as a food vendor at the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo; over the years, 19 20 the business grew to include more than two dozen locations across 21 Texas before it closed its physical stores and transitioned to special events catering; in 2010, Mr. and Mrs. Brooks retired to 22 23 their hometown of Nacogdoches, where they purchased several local

- 10 long be remembered with deep admiration and affection by all who
