R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Fred Grampp has been recognized as a 2023 80 Over
2 Eighty Honoree by Family Eldercare; and

3 WHEREAS, Family Eldercare's 80 Over Eighty is an annual event
4 that acknowledges and showcases the rich tapestry of individuals
5 over the age of 80 in Central Texas and the diversity of their
6 experiences; and

7 WHEREAS, Nominated for his exemplary record of service and
8 volunteerism, 85-year-old Fred Grampp has given generously of his
9 time and talents to numerous organizations and initiatives
10 throughout his life, including the Kiwanis Club, the Friday
11 Backpack food program at Anderson Mill Elementary, the Austin
12 Baptist Chapel Angel House Soup Kitchen, PBS, and 4-H, as well as
13 various church programs; in addition, he helped start the local
14 Hill Country Christmas Bureau working in conjunction with the Blue
15 Santa gift donation program in 1983; and

16 WHEREAS, For nearly four decades, Mr. Grampp has also been an
17 active volunteer with Hill Country Community Ministries (HCCM), a
18 nonprofit organization that provides food, clothing, and other
19 assistance to people and families in need; he previously served as
20 president of the Board of Directors, and in the early 1980s, he
21 along with his wife, Karen, helped establish HCCM's thrift store;
22 today, he continues his service with the organization in a variety
23 of ways, such as helping with the food pantry and with retail store
24 donation pickups; and

1 WHEREAS, Fred Grampp has set an inspiring example of
2 community engagement, and he has earned the lasting respect and
3 admiration of all who are privileged to know him; now, therefore, be
