R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Anagha Deepak, a junior at Round Rock High School,
2 has distinguished herself through her participation in the 2023
3 United States Youth Ambassadors Program in Ecuador; and

4 WHEREAS, Sponsored by the U.S. Department of State's Bureau
5 of Educational and Cultural Affairs, the Youth Ambassadors Program
6 brings together high school students and adult mentors from across
7 the western hemisphere to promote mutual understanding, increase
8 leadership skills, and foster a strong sense of civic
9 responsibility through in-person and virtual exchange programs;

11 WHEREAS, One of only 18 students selected to visit Ecuador
12 among thousands of applicants, Anagha Deepak was chosen based on
13 her exemplary record of service and leadership, as well as her
14 foreign language and critical thinking skills; as a youth
15 ambassador in Ecuador, she engaged in various workshops and was
16 actively involved in a number of community service initiatives,
17 such as volunteering at a local school and planting a tree in Cumbe;
18 she also immersed herself in the country's cultural practices and
19 met with personnel at the U.S. Consulate in Guayaquil in order to
20 present her ideas on multicultural areas that can help advance the
21 long-standing relationship between the U.S. and Ecuador; and

22 WHEREAS, For the final phase of her journey as a youth
23 ambassador, Ms. Deepak is undertaking a project benefiting the
24 Greater Austin community this fall; in recognition of her many

1 achievements, she has accrued numerous accolades and awards,
2 including the President's Volunteer Service Gold Award,
3 Congressional Award Bronze and Silver Medals, and a Mayor's Special
4 Recognition Award from Round Rock mayor Craig Morgan; and

5 WHEREAS, Anagha Deepak has demonstrated remarkable drive and
6 initiative in working toward her goals, and she may indeed reflect
7 with pride on her accomplishments as she looks forward to a future
8 bright with promise; now, therefore, be it
