RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, A milestone in the history of Angelo State 2 University athletics was realized in 2023 when the baseball team 3 secured its first NCAA Division II national championship; and

WHEREAS, Following an impressive performance during the 4 5 regular season, the Rams clinched their third straight Lone Star Conference Tournament title for an automatic bid to the South 6 7 Central Regional Tournament; defeating Metropolitan State University of Denver and The University of Texas at Tyler, Angelo 8 9 State moved on to the South Central Super Regional; after sweeping Colorado Mesa University, the team advanced to the NCAA Division II 10 11 College World Series in Cary, North Carolina, for the third 12 consecutive year; and

13 WHEREAS, ASU opened the World Series with wins over Southern 14 New Hampshire University and North Greenville University; next, in 15 a pivotal rematch against SNHU, the Rams prevailed 5-3 to punch 16 their ticket to the Division II title game for the first time in 17 program history; and

WHEREAS, On June 10, Angelo State faced off against Rollins College at the USA Baseball National Training Complex; the Rams built a 6-2 lead over the first eight innings and then demonstrated great resolve after the Tars rallied to pull within one run in the ninth; with the bases loaded and the national crown on the line, ASU claimed the title with a dramatic strikeout, triumphing by the final score of 6-5; the Rams ended with an outstanding record of 56

victories and 9 losses, setting school and conference win records
while claiming the university's first national championship in
men's sports; and

WHEREAS, The Rams were led by World Series Most Valuable Player Aaron Munson, who was joined by Kade Bragg, Justin Harris, and Kamden Kelton on the All-Tournament Team; benefiting from the ble leadership of head coach Kevin Brooks and his staff, the team also received valuable contributions from the other members of the roster over the course of the year; and

10 WHEREAS, Playing with exceptional skill, determination, and 11 teamwork, the Angelo State Rams realized their season-long goal of 12 becoming national champions, and their achievement will forever be 13 a proud memory for the university's loyal fans throughout Texas and 14 beyond; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby congratulate the Angelo State University baseball team on winning the 2023 NCAA Division II national championship and extend to the players, coaches, and staff sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be it further
