

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Officer Ronald Cronin of the Dallas Police  
2 Department demonstrated exceptional courage in the line of duty on  
3 July 25, 2022, when he risked his life to apprehend an armed suspect  
4 at Dallas Love Field Airport; and

5           WHEREAS, A 15-year veteran of the department, Officer Cronin  
6 was assigned to surveil the ticketing area at the airport, which was  
7 occupied by more than 100 people that morning; at around 11 a.m., he  
8 observed a woman causing a disturbance at one of the ticketing  
9 counters; just as Officer Cronin was using his radio to request  
10 backup, the suspect pulled out a handgun and began firing rounds  
11 into the air; and

12           WHEREAS, After taking cover, Officer Cronin witnessed the  
13 suspect continue to fire her weapon into the air, placing airport  
14 patrons in danger; acting without hesitation, he discharged his  
15 weapon at the suspect, immobilizing her and preventing the incident  
16 from escalating; he then rendered emergency aid to the wounded  
17 suspect, who survived and was taken into custody, as other officers  
18 arrived to secure the scene; and

19           WHEREAS, Officer Ronald Cronin distinguished himself through  
20 his efforts to bring a dangerous suspect to justice, and he is  
21 indeed deserving of recognition for his tremendous bravery and his  
22 unwavering resolve to keep his community safe; now, therefore, be  
23 it
