1           WHEREAS, Marie Gonzales is retiring as the executive director  
2 of special education at the Round Rock Independent School District  
3 on December 14, 2023, drawing to a close an exemplary career in  
4 education that has spanned 28 years; and

5           WHEREAS, Ms. Gonzales began her career as a deaf education  
6 teacher at Deerpark Middle School in August 1995, and she went on to  
7 join the faculty at McNeil High School in 2001; the following year,  
8 she became an admission, review, and dismissal facilitator, and in  
9 2008, she accepted the position of special education department  
10 chair; she later served as assistant principal and associate  
11 principal at McNeil High before taking on her current role as the  
12 district's executive director of special education; and

13           WHEREAS, Along the way, Ms. Gonzales has been involved in  
14 numerous committees and initiatives, including the Secondary  
15 Teaching & Learning Advisory Board, the launch of a dual credit  
16 program for deaf students, and the Texas Deafblind Project; she has  
17 also been active in the Delta Kappa Gamma Society International  
18 Kappa Lambda Chapter, which she served as president from 2012 to  
19 2014; among her many achievements, she received a World Class ARD  
20 Facilitator Award in 2005 and a Certificate of Appreciation for  
21 Valuable Contributions During State Assessment in 2008; and

22           WHEREAS, Ms. Gonzales holds bachelor's and master's degrees  
23 in communications, sciences, and disorders with an emphasis on deaf  
24 education from The University of Texas at Austin; in addition, she

1 completed the principal certification graduate program in  
2 educational leadership at Texas State University in 2011; and

3 WHEREAS, Through her dedication, professionalism, and  
4 commitment to excellence, Marie Gonzales has helped many young  
5 Texans acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to succeed, and  
6 her contributions will be remembered and appreciated for years to  
7 come; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas  
9 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby congratulate Marie  
10 Gonzales on her retirement as the executive director of special  
11 education at Round Rock ISD and extend to her sincere best wishes
