1 WHEREAS, Dr. Russell Lowery-Hart stepped down as president 2 of Amarillo College on September 30, 2023, and the conclusion of his service provides a fitting opportunity to recognize his many 3 significant accomplishments; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Since his appointment in 2014, Dr. Lowery-Hart has worked tirelessly to develop AC as one of the top community colleges 6 7 in the nation; over the course of his exemplary tenure, he was essential in the implementation of the college's Culture of Caring 8 initiative, and he oversaw the establishment of childcare access 9 for students with children, virtual learning space during the 10

11 COVID-19 pandemic, and the THRIVE Scholarship Program partnership, 12

as well as the launch of AC's first comprehensive campaign, Badger

Bold, and the reestablishment of Badger Athletics; furthermore, the 13

college saw a 75 percent growth rate of first-generation students 14

completing their degree or certificate, and three-year completion 15

rates more than doubled; and 16

WHEREAS, Under Dr. Lowery-Hart's able 17 leadership, AC received a number of honors, including the Leah Meyer Austin Award 18 from Achieving the Dream and the Bellwether Award; the school was 19 also recognized as a Top 5 College and received a Rising Star award 20 from the Aspen Institute in 2021, and it was named a corecipient of 21 the prestigious Aspen Prize for Community College Excellence in 22

23 2023; and

24 WHEREAS, Before becoming president, Dr. Lowery-Hart served

- 1 the college as vice president of academic affairs; he holds a
- 2 bachelor's degree in speech communication and rhetoric from West
- 3 Texas State University, a master's degree in communication studies
- 4 from Texas Tech University, and a doctorate in interpersonal
- 5 communication from Ohio University; in recognition of his myriad
- 6 accomplishments, he was named the National Council of Instructional
- 7 Administrators Academic Leader of the Year in 2014 and the 2021
- 8 Amarillo Globe-News Man of the Year; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Dr. Lowery-Hart undertook his new role as the ninth
- 10 chancellor of the Austin Community College District on October 1,
- 11 2023; in all his endeavors, he enjoys the love and support of a fine
- 12 family that includes his wife of almost 30 years, Tara, and their
- 13 three children; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Through his dedication, expertise, and visionary
- 15 leadership, Dr. Russell Lowery-Hart has played a vital role in
- 16 advancing the proud legacy of Amarillo College, and his
- 17 achievements will continue to be appreciated for years to come;
- 18 now, therefore, be it
- 19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
- 20 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby commend Dr. Russell
- 21 Lowery-Hart for his service as president of Amarillo College and
- 22 extend to him sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further
