3 Antonio on October 18, 2023, at the age of 91; and

5 Fonseca was born in El Paso on July 10, 1932; he answered the call to
6 the ministry and became the pastor of Iglesia Sur Zarzamora Baptist

18 Guadalupe Fonseca earned the lasting respect and admiration of all
19 who were privileged to know him, and they will forever cherish their
20 memories of his warmth, kindness, and wonderful sense of humor;
