R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Toyota Motor Manufacturing, Texas, Inc., in San  
2 Antonio is marking its 20th anniversary in October 2023; and

3           WHEREAS, The company broke ground on the San Antonio plant in  
4 2003 and started production three years later; representing a \$4.2  
5 billion investment in the Lone Star State, the plant has assembled  
6 over 3 million vehicles in the years since, and it is currently the  
7 only manufacturer in the world that produces the Tundra truck and  
8 the Sequoia SUV; and

9           WHEREAS, In addition to creating thousands of well-paying  
10 jobs, TMMTX has contributed to the community by donating more than  
11 \$50 million to area nonprofits; over the years, the company has  
12 supported various educational initiatives and given generously to  
13 such organizations as United Way of San Antonio and Bexar County,  
14 the San Antonio Food Bank, Big Brothers Big Sisters of South Texas,  
15 and El Centro del Barrio; in celebration of its 20th anniversary,  
16 the company donated a total of \$100,000 to the Institute for School  
17 and Community Partnership at Texas A&M University-San Antonio and  
18 The 100 Club of San Antonio, which benefits law enforcement and  
19 firefighters in Bexar County; and

20           WHEREAS, Businesses that employ Texans and that contribute to  
21 the local economy are important components of a prosperous future,  
22 and Toyota Motor Manufacturing, Texas, Inc., is deserving of  
23 recognition for the positive role it has played in the San Antonio  
24 community for the past two decades; now, therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas  
2 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby congratulate Toyota Motor  
3 Manufacturing, Texas, Inc., in San Antonio on its 20th anniversary  
4 and extend to all those associated with the plant sincere best
