- 2 Operation Lone Star in an effort to address the issue of
- 3 unauthorized immigration and to assist Texas counties in combatting
- 4 criminal activities along the southern border; and
- 5 WHEREAS, On October 24 of that year, Camp Charlie was
- 6 constructed on the land that once served the soldiers at Eagle Pass
- 7 Army Airfield during World War II; Task Force West was the first to
- 8 be activated at Camp Charlie, and in September 2022, command was
- 9 turned over to Task Force Eagle; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Camp Charlie is a 20-acre community made up of
- 11 contractors, soldiers, and local residents who are responsible for
- 12 the camp's daily operations; the soldiers at Camp Charlie proudly
- 13 support the State of Texas and their adopted city of Eagle Pass, and
- 14 they have likewise been warmly welcomed by the wider community; and
- WHEREAS, The men and women of Camp Charlie are steadfastly
- 16 dedicated to the safety and well-being of the citizens of Texas, and
- 17 their efforts are contributing to a challenging yet vital mission
- 18 for our state and nation; now, therefore, be it
- 19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
- 20 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby recognize October 24, 2023,
- 21 as Camp Charlie Day and extend deep appreciation to the personnel at
- 22 Camp Charlie for their honorable service.
