WHEREAS, Colonel Terry's career spanned three decades and 13 14 took him and his family to seven different states and two foreign countries; he served in all three of the air force's command 15 16 divisions at the time, and during the Vietnam War, he flew missions in the Military Airlift Command, carrying supplies and sometimes 17 transporting combat troops or airlifting the wounded; later 18 assigned to the Strategic Air Command, he was named deputy 19 commander of maintenance at Beale Air Force Base near Sacramento, 20 21 California; he took great pride in the achievements of the maintenance squadrons as well as the pilots of that Reconnaissance 22 23 Wing and earned their admiration and affection; moreover, he became one of the elite few to fly the SR-71; following his retirement in
