Truman; and

13 WHEREAS, Following the war, Mrs. Bell was employed at the 14 Veterans Administration Hospital in McKinney; she later 15 distinguished herself in her work as a school nurse at the North 16 Ward and West Ward Elementary Schools in McKinney prior to her 17 retirement; and

WHEREAS, On October 16, 1948, she exchanged wedding vows with army veteran Charles Bell and they shared a rewarding marriage spanning more than five and a half decades before Mr. Bell's passing in 2005; in the early years of their marriage, the couple made their home in Prosper, where they raised their two children, Tom and Cindy; and
