A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to public school selection of an alternative assessment
- 3 instrument in place of state-administered assessment instruments.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.026, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39.026. LOCAL OPTION. (a) Notwithstanding any other
- 8 provision of this title, a school district, in place of any [In
- 9 addition to the] assessment instruments required under Section
- 10 39.023 adopted by the agency and administered by the State Board of
- 11 Education, [a school district] may adopt and administer nationally
- 12 [criterion-referenced or] norm-referenced assessment instruments
- 13 <u>selected by the district</u>[, or both, at any grade level].
- 14 (b) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary for the
- 15 administration of Subsection (a), including rules for using for
- 16 purposes of this code assessment instruments adopted under that
- 17 subsection in place of the assessment instruments otherwise
- 18 required under this subchapter.
- 19 (c) If there is a conflict between Subsection (a) and
- 20 federal law or regulation, the agency shall seek a waiver from the
- 21 application of conflicting federal law or regulation.
- 22 (d) In addition to the assessment instruments adopted by the
- 23 agency and administered by the State Board of Education or the
- 24 assessment instruments adopted and administered by the district

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- 1 under Subsection (a), a school district may adopt and administer
- 2 criterion-referenced or norm-referenced assessment instruments at
- 3 <u>any grade level.</u>
- 4 (e) An [A norm-referenced] assessment instrument adopted
- 5 under this section must be economical, nationally recognized, and
- 6 approved by the agency [state-approved].
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2024-2025
- 8 school year.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 14 legislative session.
