1 WHEREAS, The Carver Center in the Midland Independent School
2 District has been named the top charter elementary school in Texas
3 for 2023 by *U.S. News and World Report*; and

4 WHEREAS, This prestigious recognition is based on reading and
5 math proficiency and performance data, which reports that
6 89 percent of Carver students have met or surpassed expectations
7 for math while 93 percent have scored at or above that level in
8 reading; the campus also ranked fourth among all elementary schools
9 in the state, coming in second in reading and seventh in math; and

10 WHEREAS, Led by executive administrator Stephanie Carnett,
11 the Carver Center serves students in first through sixth grade; to
12 gain admission to the school, students must test into the Midland
13 ISD gifted and talented program in addition to demonstrating
14 advanced reasoning skills and high achievement; and

16 students of the Carver Center have established a record of
17 scholastic excellence, and they are indeed deserving of this most
18 recent honor; now, therefore, be it
