16 University and was drafted in the third round of the 2000 Major

18 member of the Rangers and was named the team's Rookie of the Year in

19 2005; after being traded to the San Diego Padres, he was selected to

20 the 2007 National League All-Star Team, and in 2014, he was named

21 the American League Comeback Player of the Year as a member of the

22 Seattle Mariners after overcoming years of injuries; he finished

23 his career with three seasons in Kansas City and pitched 15 innings

24 during the Royals' postseason run to the 2015 World Series title;
