- 19 Bunny collaboration, "Un x100to," ranked No. 1 on the Billboard
- 20 Global 200 and Billboard Global Excl. U.S. charts, and "TULUM," a
- 21 collaboration with Peso Pluma, was featured on the Billboard Hot
- 22 100; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Grupo Frontera was nominated in 15 categories at the
- 24 2023 Billboard Latin Music Awards, including Artist of the Year and
