- 15 computer information, and applied technology at the North Harris
- 16 Campus in the Lone Star College System; he subsequently transferred
- 17 to the Kingwood Campus, and he served as executive director of

- 19 president of instruction and chief academic officer; he took on his
- 20 current role as the second president of Tarrant County College
- 21 Southeast Campus in 2012, and under his able leadership, the campus
- 22 won the prestigious Eduardo J. Padron Award for Institutional
- 23 Transformation in 2021; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Dr. Coppola has been active in numerous civic and

- 2 Chamber of Commerce Board, the City of Arlington Transportation

- 6 of Community & Technical Colleges, and the Higher Education
- 7 Research and Development Institute; he is also founding chair of
- 8 the Arlington Mayor's Education Coalition, and he has served as
