2 to providing transportation and other essential services to senior
3 citizens in the Austin area, celebrated the 30th anniversary of its
4 founding on November 9, 2023; and

7 Round Rock, Hutto, Pflugerville, Manor, and East Austin by helping
8 them to maintain their independence and remain in their homes for as

11 Senior Access offers personal transportation for medical
12 appointments and errands, assistance with household repairs and

16 to meet the needs of the local senior community; and
