WHEREAS, Mr. Bowlin served in the army from 1952 to 1954; he trained at Fort Lewis in Washington and then helped France rebuild its infrastructure; while living in the country, he and his wife formed many lasting friendships; he held the rank of first lieutenant and earned the National Defense Service Medal; and

WHEREAS, During the late 1950s, the Bowlins lived in Dallas; Mr. Bowlin worked as a civil engineer and then followed his dream of entrepreneurship, establishing a commercial insulation business; an early adopter of technology, he purchased one of the first personal computers, a Radio Shack TRS-80, and he learned to write code that he used in his business; he owned 22 personal computers over the years; and
