1           WHEREAS, For more than five decades, Albert Armendariz  
2 Jr. has rendered exceptional service to the city of El Paso in his  
3 capacity as an immigration and naturalization attorney; and

4           WHEREAS, A 1970 graduate of The University of Texas at Austin  
5 School of Law, Mr. Armendariz is a principal of Albert Armendariz,  
6 Jr., Attorney at Law, PC, which is a partner in the Law Offices of  
7 Armendariz & Holguin; through the years, he has practiced  
8 extensively in the area of federal immigration law, with an  
9 emphasis on immigration through family relationships, deportation  
10 defense, acquired and derivative U.S. citizenship, and federal  
11 court litigation; he has further distinguished himself by speaking  
12 at the State Bar of Texas Annual Meeting and the Conference on  
13 Immigration and Nationality Law, held by UT Law Continuing Legal  
14 Education; and

15           WHEREAS, Mr. Armendariz has been honored as the Outstanding  
16 Senior Lawyer by the El Paso Young Lawyers Association, and in 2009,  
17 he received the inaugural Albert Armendariz Jr. Lifetime

19 Paso; he is a member and a past president of both that entity and the  
20 El Paso Association of Immigration Practitioners; moreover, he  
21 belongs to the American Immigration Lawyers and El Paso Bar  
22 Associations, is involved with the National Lawyers Guild National  
23 Immigration Project, and is a former board chair for the Immigrant  
24 and Refugee Rights Project of the Texas Lawyers' Committee for

1 Civil Rights Under Law; and

2 WHEREAS, Through his steadfast commitment to the immigrant  
3 community, Albert Armendariz has benefited the lives of countless  
4 individuals and families in El Paso and beyond, and it is a pleasure  
5 to join in recognizing him for his myriad contributions; now,  
6 therefore, be it

8 Legislature, 4th Called Session, hereby commend Albert Armendariz  
9 Jr. for his many years of dedicated service as an immigration and
