Nodal and found crossover success in North America with the release 17

of Ariana Grande's single, "Boyfriend"; and 18

WHEREAS, With No. 1 hits in every Latin genre, Mr. Barrera 19

crafts songs that implement acoustic instruments and build on the 20

21 traditions of mariachi, salsa, bachata, and merengue; over the

years, he has cut tracks with such acclaimed artists as Christina 22

23 Aguilera, Shakira, Selena Gomez, Camila Cabello, Daddy Yankee,

Becky G, The Weeknd, and Peso Pluma; in 2015, he received a Grammy 24
