R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The football team from Liberty Christian School in
2 Argyle closed out an unforgettable season by capturing the 2023
3 Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools Division II
4 state championship; and

5 WHEREAS, The Warriors began their journey to the title by
6 going undefeated in the regular season and claiming the district
7 title; delivering a series of dominant performances in the
8 playoffs, they bested Bishop Dunne Catholic School, Grace Community
9 School, and All Saints' Episcopal School to advance to the title
10 game; and

11 WHEREAS, On December 1, Liberty Christian took the field at
12 Waco ISD Stadium against Regents School of Austin in the
13 Division II finale; showcasing a balanced attack, the Warriors took
14 control from the outset, going up 31-3 at intermission and
15 extending their advantage in the second half; triumphing by the
16 final score of 52-10, the Liberty Christian players hoisted the
17 championship trophy for the first time in 16 years, closing out the
18 season with an unblemished record of 14 wins and zero losses; and

19 WHEREAS, The success enjoyed by the Liberty Christian players
20 was the result of an exceptional team effort, with valuable
21 contributions being made by each member of the roster; over the
22 course of the championship season, the Warriors were guided by
23 third-year head coach Jason Witten, who has drawn on the gridiron
24 expertise he gained during his playing career with the Dallas

1 Cowboys to teach and motivate the Liberty Christian athletes; and

3 unwavering commitment to excellence, the Liberty Christian
4 Warriors realized their season-long goal of becoming state
5 champions, and their accomplishments are a source of great pride to
6 their school and to their many supporters in the community; now,
