 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the duration of services provided under Medicaid to
 1-20 women following a pregnancy.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 32.024(1-1), Human Resources Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (1-1) The commission shall continue to provide medical
 1-25 assistance to a woman who is eligible for medical assistance for
 1-26 pregnant women for a period of not less than:

1-27 (1) six months following the date the woman delivers
 1-28 or experiences an involuntary miscarriage; and

1-29 (2) 12 months that begins on the last day of the
 1-30 woman's pregnancy and ends on the last day of the month in which the
 1-31 12-month period ends in accordance with Section 1902(e)(16), Social
 1-32 Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1396a(e)(16)).

1-33 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
 1-34 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
 1-35 Services Commission shall, in accordance with Section 1902(e)(16),
 1-36 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1396a(e)(16)), seek from the
 1-37 appropriate federal agency an amendment to the state's Medicaid
 1-38 state plan to implement Section 32.024(1-1)(2), Human Resources
 1-39 Code, as added by this Act. The commission may delay implementing
 1-40 this Act until the state plan amendment is approved.

1-41 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-42 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-44 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-45 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
