A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of a county commissioners court to adopt
3 an exemption from ad valorem taxation by each taxing unit that taxes
4 the property of the portion of the appraised value of a person's
5 property that is attributable to the installation in or on the
6 property of certain water conservation systems.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

8 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 11, Tax Code, is amended by
9 adding Section 11.325 to read as follows:

10 Sec. 11.325. WATER CONSERVATION SYSTEMS. (a) In this
11 section, "graywater" has the meaning assigned by Section 341.039,
12 Health and Safety Code.

13 (b) The commissioners court of a county by order may adopt
14 an exemption from taxation of the portion of the appraised value of
15 a person's property that is attributable to the installation in or
16 on the property of a rainwater harvesting or graywater system. An
17 exemption adopted by a commissioners court under this section
18 applies to the taxation of property by each taxing unit that taxes
19 the property.

20 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to ad valorem taxes imposed
21 for a tax year beginning on or after the effective date of this Act.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2024, but only
23 if the constitutional amendment to authorize the commissioners
24 court of a county to exempt from ad valorem taxation by each

1 political subdivision that taxes the property the portion of the
2 assessed value of a person's property that is attributable to the
3 installation in or on the property of a rainwater harvesting or
4 graywater system is approved by the voters. If that amendment is
5 not approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
