A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to provider discrimination against a Medicaid recipient or
3	child health plan program enrollee based on immunization status.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 531.02119 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 531.02119. DISCRIMINATION BASED ON IMMUNIZATION
8	STATUS PROHIBITED. (a) A provider who participates in Medicaid or
9	the child health plan program, including a provider participating
10	in the provider network of a managed care organization that
11	contracts with the commission to provide services under Medicaid or
12	the child health plan program, may not refuse to provide health care
13	services to a Medicaid recipient or child health plan program
14	enrollee based on the recipient's or enrollee's refusal or failure
15	to obtain a vaccine or immunization for a particular infectious or
16	communicable disease.
17	(b) The commission:
18	(1) may not provide Medicaid or child health plan
19	program reimbursement to a provider who violates this section; and
20	(2) shall disenroll the provider from participation as
21	a Medicaid or child health plan program provider.
22	(c) The executive commissioner may adopt rules as necessary
23	to implement this section.

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SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act

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- 1 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 2 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 3 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 4 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 5 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
