- 14 AMBULANCE SERVICES. (a) "Balance billing" means the practice of
- 15 charging an enrollee in a health benefit plan to recover from the
- 16 enrollee the balance of a health care provider's fee for a service
- 17 received by the enrollee from the health care provider that is not
- 18 fully reimbursed by the enrollee's health benefit plan.
- (b) A county or municipality may elect to consider a health
- 20 benefit plan payment towards a claim for air or ground ambulance
- 21 services provided by the county or municipality as payment in full
- 22 for those services regardless of the amount the county or
- 23 municipality charged for those services.
- 24 (c) A county or municipality may not practice balance

- 1 billing for a claim for which the county or municipality makes an
- 2 <u>election under Subsection (b).</u>
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
