1-17 relating to the peace officers authorized to operate an authorized  
 1-18 emergency vehicle used to conduct a police escort.  
 1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-20 SECTION 1. Section 546.002(a), Transportation Code, is  
 1-21 amended to read as follows:  
 1-22 (a) In this section, "police escort" means facilitating the  
 1-23 movement of a funeral, oversized or hazardous load, or other  
 1-24 traffic disruption for public safety purposes by a peace officer  
 1-25 described by Articles 2.12(1)-(4), (8), (12), (17)(B), and (22),  
 1-26 Code of Criminal Procedure.  
 1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
