Section 8331(20). 12 (2) "Firefighter" means a member of a fire department 13 who performs a function listed in Section 419.021(3)(C), Government 14 Code. (3) "Livestock" has the meaning assigned by Section 15 1.003, Agriculture Code. 16 17 (4) "Peace officer" has the meaning assigned by Section 1.07, Penal Code, or other state or federal law. 18 (5) "Trespasser" has the meaning defined by Section 19 75.007(a), Civil Practice and Remedies Code. 20 21 (b) A landowner or lessee is not liable for damages arising from any incident or accident caused by involving livestock of the 22 23 landowner or lessee due to: 24 (1) An act or omission of a firefighter or a peace

No. 73 officer who has entered the landowner's property with or without 1 2 the permission of the landowner, regardless of whether the damage 3 occurs on the landowner's property; 4 (2) An act or omission by a trespasser who enters the 5 landowner's property or third party that damages the fence on the property, whether by vehicle or otherwise; or 6 7 (3) Due to wildlife, acts of God or by other causes 8 beyond the control of the landowner. 9 An owner, lessee, or occupant of agricultural land is (c) 10 not liable for any damage or injury to any person or property, regardless of whether the damage or injury occurs on the 11 12 agricultural land, that arises from: (1) the actions of a peace officer or federal law 13 enforcement officer when the officer enters or causes another 14 15 person to enter the agricultural land with or without the 16 permission of the owner, lessee, or occupant; 17 (2) by a trespasser who enters the landowner's property or third party who damages the fence on the property, 18 19 whether by vehicle or otherwise; or (3) due to wildlife, acts of God or by other causes 20 beyond the control of the landowner. 21 The owner, lessee, or occupant of agricultural land is 22 (d) not liable for any damage or injury to any person or property that 23 24 arises from the actions of an individual who, because of the actions of a peace officer or federal law enforcement officer, the actions 25 26 of a trespasser who enters the landowner's property or third party who damages the fence on the property, whether by vehicle or 27

3 enter the agricultural land without the permission of the owner,
4 lessee, or occupant.

5 (e) This section does not limit the liability of an owner, 6 lessee, or occupant of agricultural land for any damage or injury 7 that arises from a wilful or wanton act or gross negligence by the 8 owner, lessee, or occupant.

9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
