- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 26.04, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 7 Subsection (e-6) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(e-6)</u> The designated officer or employee of a taxing unit
- 9 required to post information on the home page of the taxing unit's
- 10 Internet website under Subsection (e) shall publish a summary of
- 11 that information and the uniform resource locator (URL) address of
- 12 the location where that information is posted in a newspaper of
- 13 general circulation in each county in which the taxing unit is
- 14 located. This subsection does not apply to a taxing unit if:
- 15 (1) the taxing unit is located wholly or partly in a
- 16 county with a population of one million or more; or
- 17 (2) no part of the taxing unit is located in a county
- 18 in which a newspaper of general circulation is published.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an ad valorem tax year that begins on or after the effective date
- 21 of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2024.
