- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 43.141, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (d-1) On the motion of the attorney representing the state,
- 8 the convicting court shall withdraw the order of the court setting a
- 9 date for execution in a death penalty case.
- SECTION 2. Article 43.141(d-1), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 11 as added by this Act, applies only to an order entered on or after
- 12 the effective date of this Act. An order entered before the
- 13 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 14 date the order was entered, and the former law is continued in
- 15 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
