- 2 relating to the use of an electronic recording device to report
- 3 proceedings before a municipal court of record for the City of San
- 4 Antonio.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 30.00226, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 8 (c) Instead of using a court reporter to preserve a record
- 9 <u>in a case</u>, the governing body may authorize the use of a good
- 10 quality electronic recording device to report court proceedings. If
- 11 the governing body authorizes an electronic recording, the court
- 12 reporter is not required to be present to certify the reporter's
- 13 record. The recording shall be kept for the 20-day period beginning
- 14 the day after the last day of the court proceeding, trial, or denial
- 15 of motion for new trial, whichever occurs last. If a case is
- 16 appealed, the proceedings shall be transcribed from the recording
- 17 by an official court reporter.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
