- 4 SECTION 1. Except as provided by Section 2 of this Act, for

- 6 (1) each full-time employee of a state agency,
- 7 including an institution of higher education as defined by Section

- 11 (2) each part-time employee of a state agency,

- 15 biennium in an amount that is equal to the product of:
- 16 (A) the ratio between the number of hours the

- SECTION 2. Section 1 of this Act does not apply to a member
- 21 of the legislature or to a member of a board, commission, or other
- 22 governing body of a state agency, including an institution of

- 24 may receive a per diem or expense reimbursement but not a salary for

- 1 full-time employment.
