4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is

6	Sec. 531.02221. WOMEN'S HEALTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE. (a)
7	The executive commissioner shall establish a women's health
8	advisory committee to provide recommendations to the commission on
9	women's health programs, including programs previously
10	consolidated by the commission.
11	(b) The executive commissioner shall appoint members to the
12	advisory committee and ensure that a majority of the members are
13	health care providers who:
14	(1) are participating in women's health programs of
15	various sizes;
16	(2) are located in separate geographic areas of this
17	state; and
18	(3) have experience in operating women's health
19	programs.
20	(c) The executive commissioner may appoint a member not
21	described by Subsection (b) to the women's health advisory
22	committee who represents the women's health industry and is
23	knowledgeable on the best practices for women's health programs.
24	(d) Section 2110.008, Government Code, does not apply to the
