- 11 subcontract price that the sum of the labor performed, materials
- 12 furnished, materials specially fabricated, reasonable overhead
- 13 costs incurred, and proportionate profit margin bears to the total
- 14 subcontract price, [+] minus
- 15  $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$  the sum of previous payments received by the
- 16 claimant on the subcontract; or
- 17 (2) the contract price minus previous payments
- 18 received by the original contractor and the claimant on the
- 19 <u>subcontract</u>.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to an original contract entered into on or after the effective date
- 22 of this Act. An original contract entered into before the effective
- 23 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 24 contract was entered into, and the former law is continued in effect
