- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 84.011, Election Code, is amended by 6
- amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 7
- follows: 8

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- 9 The officially prescribed application form for an early
- voting ballot must include: 10
- 11 (1)immediately preceding the signature space the
- certify that the information given in this 12 statement: "I
- application is true, and I understand that giving false information 13
- 14 in this application is a crime.";
- 15 (2) a statement informing the applicant the
- offenses prescribed by Sections 84.003 and 84.004; 16
- (3) entering 17 spaces for an applicant's voter
- registration number and county election precinct of registration, 18
- with a statement informing the applicant that failure to furnish 19
- 20 that information does not invalidate the application;
- 21 (3-a) a space for entering the information required
- under Section 84.002(a)(1-a); and 22
- 23 (4) on an application for a ballot to be voted by mail:
- 24 a space for an applicant applying on the

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- 1 ground of absence from the county of residence to indicate the date
- 2 on or after which the applicant can receive mail at the address
- 3 outside the county;
- 4 (B) a space for indicating the fact that an
- 5 applicant whose application is signed by a witness cannot make the
- 6 applicant's mark and a space for indicating the relationship or
- 7 lack of relationship of the witness to the applicant;
- 8 (C) a space for entering an applicant's telephone
- 9 number, with:
- 10 <u>(i)</u> a statement informing the applicant
- 11 that failure to furnish that information does not invalidate the
- 12 application; and
- 13 (ii) a statement prescribed by the
- 14 secretary of state explaining the benefits of furnishing that
- 15 information, including how that information assists the early
- 16 voting clerk;
- 17 (D) a space or box for an applicant applying on
- 18 the ground of age or disability to indicate that the address to
- 19 which the ballot is to be mailed is the address of a facility or
- 20 relative described by Section 84.002(a)(3), if applicable;
- 21 (E) a space or box for an applicant applying on
- 22 the ground of confinement in jail or involuntary civil commitment
- 23 to indicate that the address to which the ballot is to be mailed is
- 24 the address of a relative described by Section 84.002(a)(4) or (7),
- 25 if applicable;
- 26 (F) a space for an applicant applying on the
- 27 ground of age or disability to indicate if the application is an

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application under Section 86.0015;
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                        spaces for entering the signature, printed
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   name, and residence address of any person assisting the applicant;
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                    (H) a statement informing the applicant of the
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   condition prescribed by Section 81.005; and
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                    (I) a statement informing the applicant of the
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   requirement prescribed by Section 86.003(c).
         (c) The secretary of state shall make the statement
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   prescribed by Subsection (a)(4)(C)(ii) available on

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
