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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the Internet broadcast or audio recording of certain 3 open meetings. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 551, Government Code, is amended by adding Sections 551.024 and 551.025 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 551.024. INTERNET BROADCAST AND ARCHIVE OF OPEN 7 MEETINGS. (a) This section applies only to a governmental body 8 9 that is an agency within the executive or legislative branch of state government to which the total appropriation made in the 10 11 General Appropriations Act from general revenue for any fiscal year 12 beginning on or after September 1, 2023, including any amount of general revenue transferred to the governmental body under that Act 13 14 for that fiscal year, is greater than \$10 million and for which the bill pattern for the General Appropriations Act for the same fiscal 15 16 year designates 100 or more full-time employees. (b) A governmental body that becomes subject to this section 17 under Subsection (a) for a fiscal year shall comply with this 18 section in each following fiscal year. 19 (c) A governmental body subject to this section shall 20 21 broadcast over the Internet live video and audio of each open meeting of the governmental body. The governmental body shall 22 23 provide access to the broadcast on the governmental body's Internet website. 24

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1 (d) Not later than the seventh day after the date an open 2 meeting is broadcast under this section, the governmental body shall make available through the governmental body's Internet 3 website archived video and audio of the open meeting. 4 The 5 governmental body shall maintain the archived video and audio of the open meeting on the governmental body's Internet website until 6 7 the second anniversary of the date the archived video and audio was 8 first made available on the website.

9 <u>(e) The governmental body shall provide on the governmental</u> 10 <u>body's Internet website the same notice of the open meeting that the</u> 11 <u>governmental body is required to post under Subchapter C. The</u> 12 <u>notice must be posted on the governmental body's Internet website</u> 13 <u>within the time required for posting notice under Subchapter C.</u>

14 (f) The governmental body may use for an Internet broadcast 15 of an open meeting of the governmental body a room made available to 16 the governmental body on request in any state building, as defined 17 by Section 2165.301.

18 (g) The governmental body is exempt from the requirements of 19 this section to the extent a catastrophe, as defined by Section 20 551.0411, or a technical breakdown prevents the governmental body 21 from complying with this section. Following the catastrophe or 22 technical breakdown, the governmental body shall make all 23 reasonable efforts to make the required video and audio of the open 24 meeting available in a timely manner.

(h) The governmental body shall consider contracting
 through competitive bidding with a private individual or entity to
 broadcast and archive an open meeting subject to this section to

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1 minimize the cost of complying with this section.

Sec. 551.025. INTERNET ACCESS TO AUDIO RECORDING OF OPEN
MEETING. (a) This section applies only to a governmental body that
is an agency within the executive or legislative branch of the state
government to which Section 551.024 does not apply.

6 (b) Not later than the seventh day after the date an open 7 meeting is held, a governmental body subject to this section shall 8 make available through the governmental body's Internet website or 9 a social media account associated with the governmental body an 10 audio recording of the open meeting.

11 (c) The governmental body shall provide on the governmental 12 body's Internet website or a social media account associated with 13 the governmental body the same notice of the open meeting that the 14 governmental body is required to post under Subchapter C. The 15 notice must be posted on the governmental body's Internet website 16 or a social media account associated with the governmental body 17 within the time required for posting notice under Subchapter C.

18 (d) The governmental body is exempt from the requirements of 19 this section to the extent a catastrophe, as defined by Section 20 551.0411, or a technical breakdown prevents the governmental body 21 from complying with this section. Following the catastrophe or 22 technical breakdown, the governmental body shall make all 23 reasonable efforts to make the required audio recording of the open 24 meeting available in a timely manner.

25 SECTION 2. Sections 551.024 and 551.025, Government Code, 26 as added by this Act, apply only to an open meeting held on or after 27 September 1, 2025.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
