SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Section 411.0716(b), Government 2 Code, the change in law made by this Act to Section 411.072, 3 4 Government Code, applies only to a person described by Subsection (a) of that section who receives a dismissal and discharge under 5 6 Article 42A.111, Code of Criminal Procedure, on or after the effective date of this Act. A person who receives a dismissal and 7 discharge under Article 42A.111, Code of Criminal Procedure, before 8 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on 9 the date the dismissal and discharge was received, and the former 10 law is continued in effect for that purpose. 11
